In addition, volunteers working with children must TB Test, Fingerprinting, Central Registry, SLED and Sex Offender checks, and three reference checks. The only exception to these requirements are those volunteer groups or individuals who come to campus for one-time events or activities that are supervised by Tamassee staff. All criminal history checks must be completed annually.
