Position Summary: The Cook will provide nutritious, tasty meals and quality food service in an atmosphere to

cleanliness, cheerfulness, and personal caring.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities

- Assist in the preparation and serving of daily menus and other special meals as assigned by the Manager of Food Services.
- Responsible for the day to day cleanliness, sanitation, and appearance of unit as assigned by the Manager, as well as
 the safety of unit.
- Responsible for maintaining a high standard of personal hygiene.
- Responsible for the security of inventory and food services equipment.
- Assist in training and supervision of food service work study students teaching responsibility and respect.
- Cleans, cuts, prepares, and cooks meat, fish, or poultry to a safe temperature.
- Prepares and cooks various items according to menus, special dietary or nutritional requirements, or numbers of portions to be served.
- Apportions and serves food to guests, employees, and students.
- Washes cooking equipment such as pots, pans, dishes, utensils, and other pieces.
- Inventories supplies and equipment.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Competencies

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Basic understanding of or ability to learn sanitation and regulations for workplace safety.
- Basic understanding of or ability to learn food handling techniques, preparation, and cooking procedures.
- Must be able to work quickly and efficiently.
- Must be able to work well as part of a team.
- Must be able to work well under pressure.
- Ability to maintain personal cleanliness.

Required Qualifications

- High school Diploma or equivalent, vocational school coursework in kitchen basics, such as food safety, preferred.
- One year of related experience preferred.
- Flexibility to work afterschool program hours, especially as seasons and service needs change.

Work Environment

This job operates in a kitchen, cafeteria style environment. This role routinely uses standard kitchen equipment such as diswashers, ovens, cutlery, and cooking utensils. Community-based location that serves youth, families and community members daily. Frequent contact with employees, community-based organizations, families, students, and community members.

Physical Demands
